The undersigned organizations are writing to express our support for the transit revenue recommendations set forth by the Expenditure Plan Advisory Committee. Continuing to allocate 55 percent of Measure A revenue to Marin Transit is critical to maintaining the transit services Marin County residents, businesses, workers, and families depend on.

Our organizations primarily serve Marin County's Latino families. Collectively, we provide immigration legal services, food assistance, youth services, mental health support, English as a Second Language instruction, and citizenship classes.

Many of our clients are living in poverty and rely on Marin Transit to access our services as well as travel to work, school, doctors' visits, and other activities. In fact, low-income Latino residents are among the top users of public transportation in Marin County.

It is crucial that the county maintains current investment in Marin Transit services and explore ways to improve the transportation that is a lifeline for our community.

We thank the EPAC for recognizing the contribution of Marin Transit and the important role it plays in the lives of Latino families.
